Neighborhood Trees Surveyed Southern Manhattan - Community Board 3

60 neighborhood trees were surveyed in the East Greenwich Village neighborhood of Manhattan. Most trees are located in Community Board 3. Of the trees surveyed, 5 were in excellent condition, 46 in good condition, 6 in poor condition, and 3 were dead. 22 of the trees are Honeylocust (Gleditsia triacanthos), 11 are Callery pear (Pyrus calleryana), and 8 are Littleleaf Linden (Tilia cordata). The most valuable tree surveyed is an estimated 72 year old London plane tree (Platanus x acerifolia) in poor condition valued at \$2,259.00. The 2nd and 3rd most valuable trees are a Callery pear (Pyrus calleryana) and a Japanese Pagoda Tree (Styphnolobium japonicum) both valued at \$1,924.00 and in good condition.
